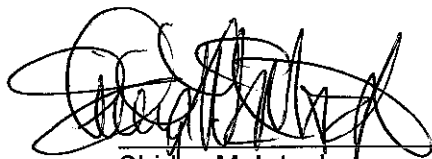

Fiscal- A copy of July's Bank Rec and Fund Report presented to council. School expected to close Tuesday or Wednesday.

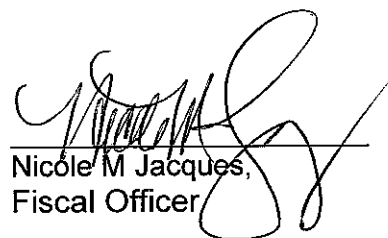
